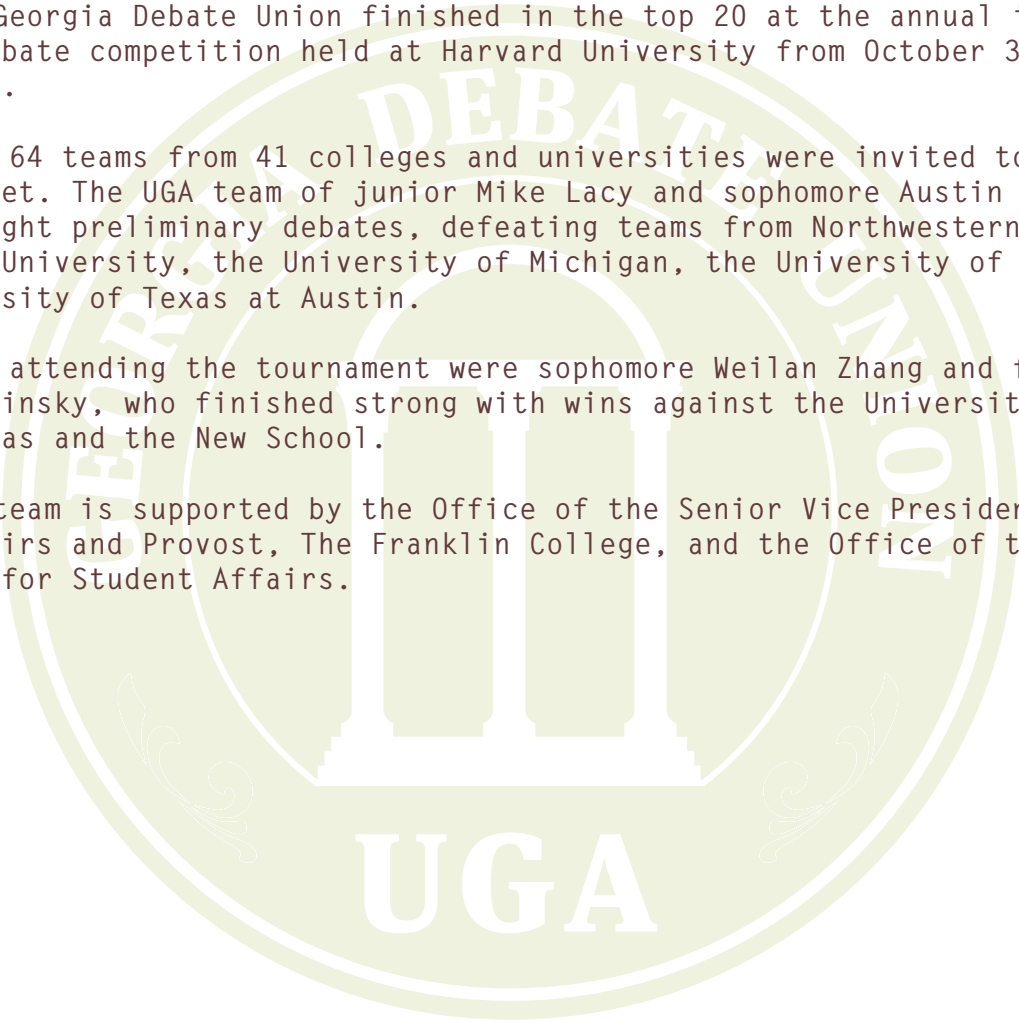
Top 20 Finish for the Georgia Debate Union at Harvard

The Georgia Debate Union finished in the top 20 at the annual intercollegiate debate competition held at Harvard University from October 30 through November 1.

Only 64 teams from 41 colleges and universities were invited to Cambridge for the meet. The UGA team of junior Mike Lacy and sophomore Austin Layton won five of eight preliminary debates, defeating teams from Northwestern University, Emory University, the University of Michigan, the University of Kansas, and the University of Texas at Austin.

Also attending the tournament were sophomore Weilan Zhang and freshman Adam Kostrinsky, who finished strong with wins against the University of Nevada at Las Vegas and the New School.

The team is supported by the Office of the Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs and Provost, The Franklin College, and the Office of the Vice President for Student Affairs.
